The guys are "manning" the SAGS while we enjoy a great day of cycling. The beautiful, historic city of Natchez, Mississippi will be the location for this exciting event. The ride will include a view over the Mississippi River, downtown Natchez, historic sites, and the southern end of the Natchez Trace. The terrain is mainly rolling hills providing just enough of a challenge.



The Rides

All rides start on the Mississippi River bluff at the corner of Main and Broadway, continue through downtown Natchez, and out to the Natchez Trace. The 8:30 AM mass start will have a police escort out of town. Riders have the option of choosing one of several well-marked and SAG supported routes.

16 miles—Girls' School

Ride out to the historic site of the Elizabeth Female Academy.

28 miles—Taste of the Trace

This route will take riders to Emerald Mound, one of the largest Indian mounds in North America.

48 miles—Church Hill Loop

Ride past antebellum mansions and historic Christ Church.

57 miles—Natchez State Park

Includes the Church Hill Loop and a turn through the park.
